

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017 Kuluin State School will receive

\$263,300*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students meet the National Minimum Standard in Literacy or have an Individual Curriculum Plan.
- Increase the number of Year 3 students achieving Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Reading to 45% and Numeracy to 35%
- Increase the number of Year 5 students achieving U2B in Reading to 25% and Numeracy to 35%.
- Develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are operating above or below year level expectations in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Engage 100% of teaching staff in the gradual release of responsibility model in Mathematics and Reading and associated professional development.
- Increase student attendance data to 94% and build parents knowledge of Every Day Counts.
- Increase participation in parent education programs.
- Provide immediate teacher aide relief to maximise student learning outcomes.
- Involve 100% of Prep students in a Fantastic Fingers Fine Motor skills program and gross motor program.

Our initiatives include

- Professional development and coaching for all teachers in Reading and Mathematics.
- Data analysis of student Reading and Numeracy to occur twice per term.
- Moderating student Reading and Mathematics once per term.
- Professional development and coaching for all teachers in Reading and Mathematics.
- Continued implementation of intervention programs in Literacy and Numeracy to support targeted students.
- Continued implementation of enrichment programs for more able targeted students.
- Provide parent education and communication regarding Every Day Counts.
- Fine and Gross Motor Program to run for 30 weeks with 10 weeks of intervention for targeted students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Building teacher capability in explicit teaching of Literacy, Numeracy and KAGAN Co-operative Learning structures by employing pedagogical coaches and Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy. | \$162,000 |
| • Providing ongoing professional development activities and teacher release for planning in Numeracy and KAGAN co-operative structures. | \$ 32,000 |
| • Purchasing resources including fine and gross motor, Literacy, Numeracy, well-being and KAGAN. | \$ 32,300 |
| • Implementing special project support for student attendance. | \$ 27,000 |
| • Providing Teacher aide replacement. | \$ 10,000 |
