

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019
Kuluin State School will receive

\$248,101*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students meet the National Minimum Standard in Literacy (NAPLAN) or have an Individual Curriculum Plan.
- Increase the number of Year 3 students achieving results in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Reading to 60% and Numeracy to 60%.
- Increase the number of Year 5 students achieving results in the (U2B) in Reading to 50% and Numeracy to 35%
- Develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are operating above or below year level expectations in English and Mathematics.
- Embed the gradual release of responsibility model in Mathematics and Reading and associated professional development. Engage in research to commence a plan for the gradual release of responsibility model in Writing.
- Increase student attendance data to 95% and continue to build parents knowledge of Every Day Counts.
- Increase parent knowledge of school priorities. Utilise Professional Learning Teams to enact plan.
- Provide intervention programs for targeted students in Prep – Year 3.
- Provide additional teacher aide support and immediate teacher aide relief to maximise student learning outcomes.

Our initiatives include

- Professional development and coaching for all teachers in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- Ongoing data analysis of student Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- Year level moderation of student Writing and Mathematics to occur once per semester.
- Continued implementation of intervention programs in Reading and Mathematics to support targeted students.
- Continued implementation of enrichment programs for identified able students.
- Provide parent education workshops and/or materials in Reading and Mathematics.
- Invest in teacher release for teachers to enhance teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum.
- Provide regular communication regarding Every Day Counts.

* Funding amount estimated on 2018 data. Actual funding will be determined after 2019 enrolment data are finalised. Actual expenditure may be varied due to changes in finalised 2019 enrolment data and student learning needs.



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Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Building teacher capability and leadership team capability in explicit teaching of English, Mathematics and KAGAN structures by employing pedagogical coaches and external leadership coach. \$110 000
- Providing Teacher aide support and immediate replacement. \$32 200
- Providing special project support for student attendance. \$27 000
- Intensive literacy support for English as an Additional Language or Dialect. \$7 401
- Providing professional development and teacher release aligned to school priorities. \$20 000
- Providing teacher release for year level teachers to plan with leadership team. \$6 500
- Introducing planning cycle 2 hours/term for teachers to plan English with the Head of Curriculum. \$23 000
- Purchasing resources for Excellence Program, Literacy, Numeracy and KAGAN. \$22 000
