This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students meet the National Minimum Standard in Literacy in the National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy (NAPLAN) or have an Individual Curriculum Plan.
- Increase the number of Kuluin Year 3 students achieving Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Writing to previous percentage for Australian Performance. Year 3 53% and Year 5 20%.
- Increase the number of Kuluin Year 3 students achieving U2B in Reading to previous percentage for Australian Performance. Year 3 55% and Year 5 41%.
- Increase the number of Kuluin Year 3 students achieving U2B in Numeracy to previous percentage for Australian Performance. Year 3 36.5% and Year 5 29%.
- Develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are operating above or below year level expectations in English and Mathematics.
- Maintain and preserve Kuluin State School's programs for Reading, Writing and Numeracy. Embed the Gradual Release of Responsibility model along with KAGAN (co-operative group learning) in all classrooms.
- Increase student attendance data to 95% and continue to build parents knowledge of 'Every Day Counts'.
- Implement case management and provide intervention programs for targeted students.
- Provide additional teacher aide support to maximise student learning outcomes.

- Professional development and coaching for all staff in Kuluin Way Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Data analysis and alignment to curriculum and pedagogy programs internal monitoring, NAPLAN,
 A-E data.
- Year level moderation of student writing and external moderation in English.
- Continued implementation of intervention programs in Literacy and Mathematics to support targeted students.
- Continued implementation of enrichment programs and implementation of Kuluin SS's Excellence Program.
- Informing parents of school improvement priorities across the school workshops and/or multimedia materials.
- Implementing The Kuluin P-2 Early Years Program based on research related to the Science of Reading.
- Investing in teacher release to enhance teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum full implementation.
