**Under this agreement for 2021
Kuluin State School will receive**

\$263,806*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students meet the National Minimum Standard in Literacy or have an Individual Curriculum Plan.
- Increase the number of Kuluin Year 3 students achieving Upper Two Bands in Writing to previous percentage for Australian Performance. Year 3 – 51% and Year 5 – 40%.
- Increase the number of Kuluin Year 3 students achieving Upper Two Bands in Number to previous percentage for Australian Performance. Year 3 – 17% and Year 5 – 29%.
- Develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are operating above or below year level expectations in English and Mathematics.
- Embed the gradual release of responsibility model in Mathematics and Reading. Continue to develop whole school plan for the gradual release of responsibility model in Writing and associated professional development.
- Increase student attendance data to 95% and continue to build parents knowledge of Every Day Counts.
- Increase parent knowledge of school priorities – multi-media and school teams to support knowledge.
- Provide intervention programs for targeted students in Prep – Year 3.
- Provide additional teacher aide support and immediate teacher aide relief to maximise student learning outcomes.

Our initiatives include

- Providing professional development and coaching for all staff in Writing.
- Undertaking data analysis and checking alignment to curriculum and pedagogy programs - internal monitoring data, A-E data.
- Undertaking year level moderation of student writing and external moderation in one Key Learning Area.
- Continued implementation of intervention programs in Literacy and Mathematics to support targeted students.
- Continued implementation of enrichment programs for identified students. Continue Kuluin's Excellence Program.
- Informing parents of key writing priorities across the school - workshops and/or multimedia materials.
- Investing in teacher release to enhance teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum – full implementation.



Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Building teacher capability and leadership team capability in explicit teaching of Writing, Mathematics and KAGAN structures by employing pedagogical coaches. \$110 000
 - Providing Teacher aide support and immediate replacement. \$28 000
 - Providing special project support for student attendance. \$40 806
 - Providing professional development and teacher release aligned to school priorities \$39 000
 - Embedding planning cycle 2 hours/term for teachers to plan English with the Head of Curriculum. \$23 000
 - Purchasing resources for Excellence Program, Literacy, Numeracy and KAGAN. \$23 000
